Safe: All schools will be upgraded with safety and security measures such as interior and exterior cameras, digital locks, campus wide intercoms and operable systems with first responders.

Modern: Our children are learning in school buildings constructed before the first lunar landing, and we have to accelerate the process to prepare our facilities for the next 50-100 years. Newer schools are also 1.5 times more efficient to operate.

Accessible: In-demand specialty programs such as STEM, Arts, Early/Middle College options and a wide range of Career & Technical Education programs will be expanded to ensure they are accessible to children at all income levels.

Renovated: The needs of every school will be addressed, including rebuilding 19 schools, renovating 12 schools and constructing 3 new schools. New school designs will align with modern safety, security and technology standards.

Tech-ready: Classrooms and facilities will be upgraded with equipment and technology to support today's approach to learning. Outdated instructional technology, devices and equipment will be replaced with new tech for teacher and student use.
